Well, we are now into February which typically means I have already tossed the diet plans. Here comes Valentine's Day, complete with all the chocolate goodies. My will power to follow a full-blown diet may have subsided but I still try to eat relatively healthy. I stumbled across a recipe for strawberry popcorn that will make that Valentine's evening of Netflixing a little less fattening.

Ingredients:

- 1 pkg. of microwavable popcorn
- 1 tbs. of butter
- 1 c. freeze dried strawberries
- 1 c. dark chocolate chips

Pop the popcorn per the package

instructions. After popping, melt butter in a pan and add the popcorn. Distribute evenly. Use a food processor to blend 1-2 tbs. of the strawberries. Sprinkle the strawberry dust over the popcorn. Spread the popcorn out on a sheet of wax paper, sprinkling the remaining strawberries over the popcorn. Melt the dark chocolate chips and drizzle over the popcorn. Let cool and store in an air tight


